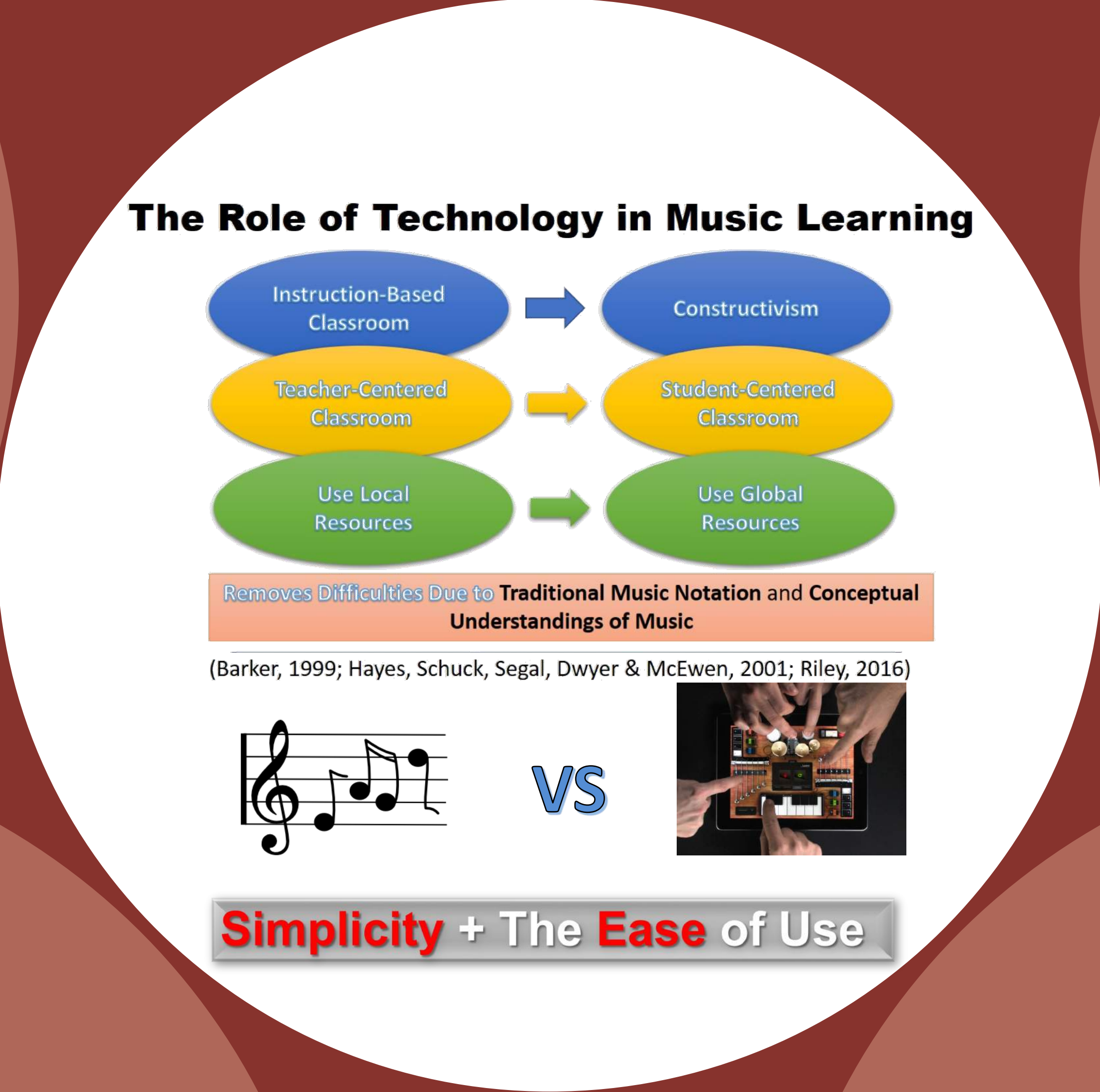

Traditional Korean stringed musical instrument of the zither family with both bridges and frets With 6 strings



iPad as a legitimate musical instrument







Shakuhachi:
